The City of Key West Department of Transportation invites party goers to "Park and Ride with Us" for a safe and responsible Fantasy Fest 2009



Public Transportation:

Regular City Bus Service - Fantasy Fest Week (10/23/09 – 11/01/09)

- Road closures and increased traffic during the week of Fantasy Fest (10/23/08 - 11/01/09) will cause delays and detours to regular bus service and schedule times.
- Buses will not provide service west of Simonton Street on Friday 10/30/09, 12:00 pm (noon) through Saturday 10/31/09, due to road closures. Regular scheduled bus service will resume on 11/01/09.
- Events planned throughout the week may prevent buses from servicing stops west of Simonton Street - updated information will be posted on the City's website at www.keywestcity.com and on the City's Real Time Passenger Information System at www.kwtransit.com or call (305) 600-1455.
- On Saturday 10/31/09, regular bus service will operate until 4:59 pm, at which time all City and Lower Keys bus services will discontinue and convert to shuttle buses servicing Fantasy Fest.

Captain Morgan "SAFE RIDE" FREE Shuttles:

The City of Key West Department of Transportation is pleased to announce the return of the **Captain Morgan Safe Ride FREE Shuttle bus** service for the **2009** annual parade event.

- **FREE** Shuttles will operate on **Saturday 10/31/09** between **5:00 pm** and **2:00 am**. Shuttles end at 2:00 am - this includes travel time.
- **Lower Keys** shuttles must depart Key West no later than **12:30 am** (after **midnight**) for return trips to Marathon. **City buses** will have a final call of **1:45 am**.
- The designated drop off / pick up point for the FREE shuttles is Fausto's on Fleming and Bahama Streets. Plan your return trip in advance as seating capacities are limited. Information on routes will be available at www.keywestcity.com and at www.kwtransit.com.

Municipal Parking:

The City operates three (3) municipal parking lots at the following locations and the following rates:

1) Old Town Garage (Park N' Ride)	\$2.00 / hr or \$13 / day
2) Mallory Square	\$4.00 / hr or \$32 / day
3) Key West Bight	\$2.50 / hr or \$16.25 / day

Oversize Vehicle Information (RV's, Tour Buses, Motor Homes, Other)

Please be aware that City Ordinances **prohibit parking of oversized vehicles** within the City. Passenger drop off and pick up sites are designated on the East side of the island up to and including White Street.

Read below for oversize vehicle accommodations.

Key West High School – Fees & Services

Parking ONLY - The City refers oversized vehicles to the Key West High School, at 2100 Flagler Avenue. Parking is available Friday 10/30/09, beginning at 6:00pm and Saturday 10/31/09, beginning at 8:00 am, with the rates as follows: Rates are based on a 24-hour maximum period.

- \$30 (RV's / Motor homes) Please pre-register these vehicles
- \$25 (Tour Buses / Buses) Please pre-register these vehicles
- \$10 (All Other Vehicles)

Shuttles TOO! - Shuttle services at the Key West High School will kick off at 12:00 pm (noon) on Saturday, 10/31/09. The fee is \$5 / person / trip - shuttles end at 12:01 am (midnight).
